

**St. Bonaventure High School Summer School 2020 Info Sheet  
for Freshmen (students who will be in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade in the 2020-2021 school year)**

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## Terms and Conditions

- St. Bonaventure High School Summer School is open to all currently enrolled students, incoming freshmen, and anyone specifically recommended.
- Tuition is \$150 for Health. Tuition for one Skills class is \$150; tuition for two Skills classes is a total of \$250.
- Health is an independent study class which starts on June 22 and ends on July 17.
- Skills Classes will be distance learning classes that will meet from June 29 through July 17.
  - Much of the work for the Skills Classes will be completed independently. Students and families are responsible for following class pacing and communicating with the teacher.
- **Please note:** Friday, July 3, will be a school holiday; no work will be assigned for that day.

## Rules and Regulations

1. St. Bonaventure High School reserves the right to cancel classes with an insufficient number of students enrolled.
2. Tuition is refundable if the school cancels the class; tuition is non-refundable if the student or family withdraws from summer school.
3. Students are required to register for and regularly utilize Google Classroom. This will be the primary access point for the courses and the location of assignments for submission.
4. Students must check for and respond to teacher feedback through Google Classroom and St. Bonaventure High School Gmail accounts.
5. Students in Skills classes must attend all distance learning Zoom (or other video platform meetings) as scheduled by the teacher.
  - a. Appropriate dress must be worn for all distance learning Zoom (or other video platform meetings.)
  - b. Video must be used during all video platform meetings. Participation is required through verbal and non-verbal communication.
  - c. Appropriate behavior is expected of all students. The administration reserves the right to determine appropriate behavior. Students who behave inappropriately will be asked to withdraw from summer school.
  - d. Students are expected to be on time and present for all remote class meetings. Parents are asked to call the attendance office at 805-648-6836 x 100 and email Mr. Meade at [gmeade@sbhsvta.org](mailto:gmeade@sbhsvta.org) if a student is unable to attend a remote class meeting.
6. Grades for all classes will be issued and will be recorded on the transcript in August.
