Terms and Conditions

1. St. Bonaventure High School Summer School is open to all currently enrolled students, incoming freshmen, and anyone specifically recommended.
2. Tuition is \$100 for Skills Classes.

Rules and Regulations

1. We reserve the right to cancel classes with an insufficient number of students enrolled.
2. Tuition is refundable if the school cancels the class; tuition is non-refundable if the student or family withdraws from summer school.
3. Appropriate dress must be worn: no short shorts, halter tops, sleeveless tops, sundresses, beach wear, board or athletic shorts, flip-flops, hats, facial hair, earrings on boys, piercings other than earrings on girls, etc. The administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate.
4. Appropriate behavior is expected of all students. The administration reserves the right to determine appropriate behavior. Students who behave inappropriately will be asked to withdraw from summer school.
